




## Teacher's Note

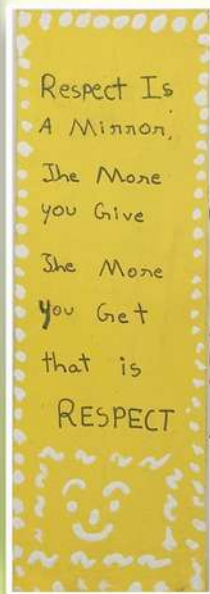

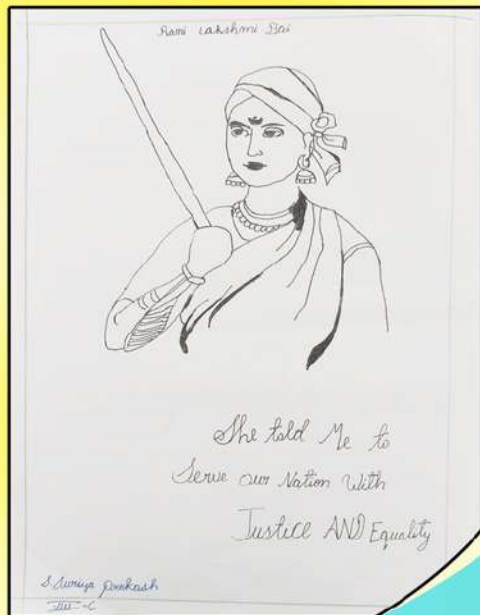
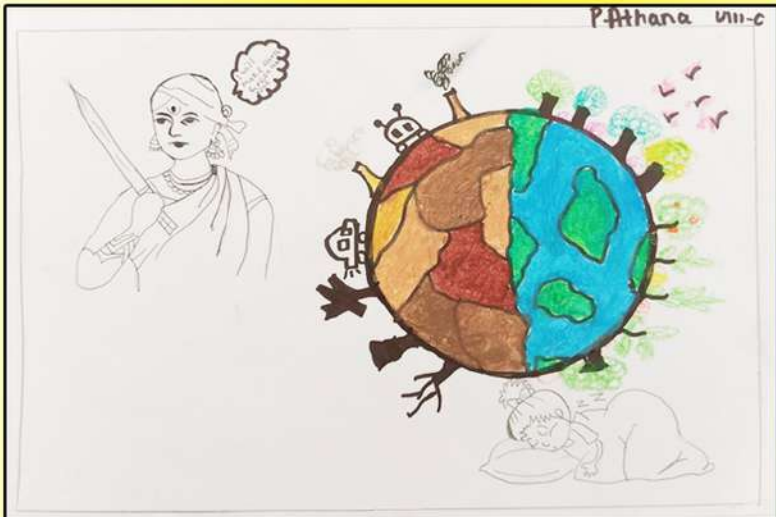


Rani Lakshmbai came into my dream. She wanted to serve our nation by "Courage."
